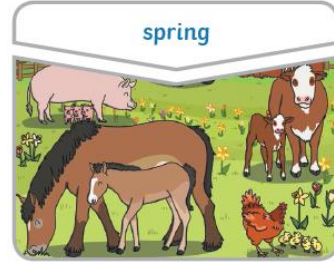

Key Vocabulary	
Seasons	There are 4 seasons each year.
Autumn	The weather begins to get colder and the amount of daylight is less. The leaves fall off the trees.
Winter	The weather is much colder. Sometimes it snows. Many trees have bare branches.
Spring	The weather starts to get warmer, leaves begin to grow on the trees and plants begin to flower and animals are born.
Summer	The weather gets hotter and the daytime is long and the nights are short.
Weather	This includes the temperature, wind direction, rain, cloud, snow and sun.
Daylight	When it is light outside.
