TTHT provides support to autistic children, young people, adults & their families, without requiring a referral or even a confirmed autism diagnosis. Our services include:

- Face-to-face and virtual family support appointments for parents/carers.
- Targeted webinars (please see our website www.ttht.co.uk and our Facebook page: The Toby Henderson Trust- for more information).
- Monthly book club for parents/carers .
- Monthly families of autistic girls support group via Zoom.
- Monthly Grandparents support group via Zoom.
- Monthly groups for autistic children & young people age 6+.
- Monthly sibling support group for children aged 6+ who have an autistic brother or sister.
- Borrow Boxes and Bags scheme: A lending service of sensory items, equipment and activities.
- Exclusive hire of Toby's Magical Garden for families during school holidays.
- XRT: Personalised therapy to address anxieties and fears, using person led CBT alongside immersive virtual reality.
